Mr. Douglas Jenkins introduced the Board's student guest from Buckeye High School, Andrew B. Price, together with his mother, father, and Principal Corky Yates. A brief summary of Andrew's academic achievements and school/community extracurricular activities was presented.

The Board recognized Cherokee Elementary and Hayden R. Lawrence Middle Schools for the bulletin board displays in the lobby of the School Board Office for the month of December, 1994.

Davis and seconded by Mr. Kenneth Doyle to add items to the agenda to discuss complaints about lunchroom services, to authorize advertisement for bids for purchase of a meat smoker for Poland Jr. High School, to authorize President Williams to execute a release of the Board's lease with Exxon Corp. for construction of a pumping station and storage tank for Plainview High

School, to endorse the Police Jury's efforts in establishing a job training residential area at Camp Claiborne, and to appoint Ms. Rosa Boykins as a 12 month Chapter I coordinator for the Computer-Assisted Instruction Program and authorize advertisement for a ten month coordinator to replace her.

She briefly highlighted each gentleman's accomplishments during his service on the Board, Mr. Jenkins having served for 21 years and been president three times, Mr. Williams having served for 20 years and having had the distinction of being the first black to serve as president, and Mr. Davis having served for four years, during which he was vice president for one year.

The Board received the thanks of Assistant District Attorney Tom Yeager for having printed the Child Abuse Awareness brochures.

The officers and members of the Executive Board of the Rapides Parents' Council were introduced by Mrs. Jane Shank, coordinator of Parental & Community Involvement. They were Dr. Tom Kelly (president), Rev. Glenn Lueng (vice president), Vera Hanley Jones (secretary-treasurer), and Rev. Stephen Y. Brady, Joyce F. Gaymon, Nanette Harms, and Frances LaCour.

A motion was made by Mr. Douglas Jenkins and seconded by Mr. Wade H. Davis, Jr. to direct Attorney James Downs to have maps of the School Board taxing districts

commercially duplicated for the use of the Board, other public offices, and the public and to approve and adopt said maps and an ordinance clarifying and reestablishing the boundaries of the taxing districts as specified as follows:

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS the Rapides Parish School Board has historically created a number of school board taxing districts, specifically Alexandria School District Number 1 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Rigolette School District Number 11 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Forest Hill School District Number 16 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Co-tile School District Number 22-A of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Glenmora School District Number 27 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Big Island School District Number 50 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Fifth Ward School District Number 51 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Pineville School District Number 52 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Poland School District Number 55 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Ruby-Wise School District Number 56 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Lecompte-Lamourie-Woodworth School District Number 57 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Sixth Ward School District Number 58 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; Forest Hill-Cheneyville-Lecompte-Lamourie-Woodworth Consolidated School District Number 61 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana, a consolidation of Forest Hill School District Number 16, Cheneyville School District Number 3, and Lecompte-Lamourie-Woodworth School District Number 57 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; and Consolidated School District Number 62 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana, a consolidation of Alexandria Consolidated School District Number 1 and Rapides School District Number 9 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS the legal descriptions of the above-mentioned school board taxing districts contain some vague and ambiguous calls which, if not clarified or corrected, might be construed to create a conflict or overlap of the several taxing district boundaries; and

WHEREAS it is the intent of the Rapides Parish School Board that the electorate of the various taxing districts and the various governmental offices concerned with elections and property assessments, including the Rapides Parish Clerk of Court, the Rapides Parish Tax Assessor and the Rapides Parish Registrar of Voters, be furnished with descriptions and maps of the various taxing districts that are clear and ambiguous in order to provide for orderly tax elections which may be submitted to the

electorate of the various districts in the future, and

WHEREAS it is desirable that the descriptions of the various districts be compiled in one ordinance, and that maps and an index of maps of the said districts be available for public use and inspection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE RAPIDES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD, IN LEGAL SESSION DULY CONVENEED, THAT THE BOUNDARIES OF THE ABOVE-MENTIONED SCHOOL BOARD TAXING DISTRICTS ARE CLARIFIED AND REESTABLISHED BY THE RAPIDES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD, ALL AS SHOWN ON THE LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF THE INDIVIDUAL DISTRICTS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE PART HEREOF.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED THAT, TO FURTHER CLARIFY AND DEMONSTRATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SAID TAXING DISTRICTS, THE RAPIDES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD DOES HEREBY ADOPT AND CONSTITUTE AS THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID DISTRICTS THAT CERTAIN SET OF MAPS OF SAID DISTRICTS COMPILED BY RUFUS M. SMITH, RAPIDES PARISH ASSESSOR'S OFFICE (RET.), WHICH SERIES OF TAXING DISTRICT MAPS HAVE BEEN PARAPHESED "NE VARIETUR" BY JAMES C. DOWNS, ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY AND ATTORNEY FOR THE RAPIDES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD, TO IDENTIFY WITH THE ORDINANCE OF THE RAPIDES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD DULY ADOPTED THIS DATE.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED THAT IN THE EVENT OF A CONFLICT OR DISCREPANCY BETWEEN THE METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION OF ANY DISTRICT DESCRIBED HEREIN AND THE MAPS OF THE SAID DISTRICTS REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING PARAGRAPH, THE BOUNDARY OF THE SAID DISTRICT SHOWN ON THE MAP SHALL CONTROL.
